- used as a light box for art – tracing

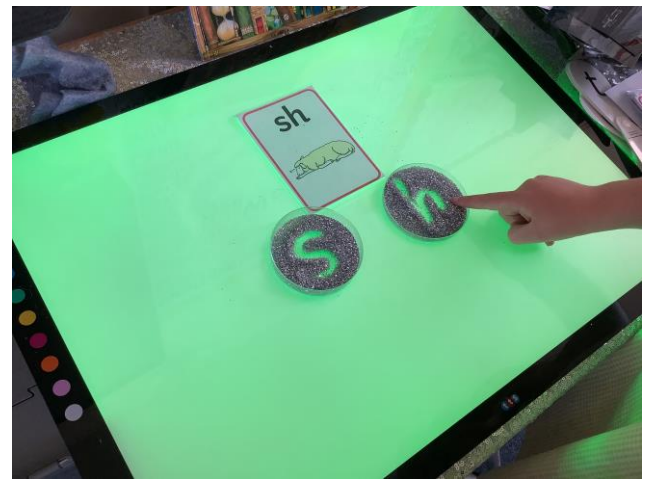
#### Science

- X-rays comparing, classifying and identifying in Animals including Humans topic.



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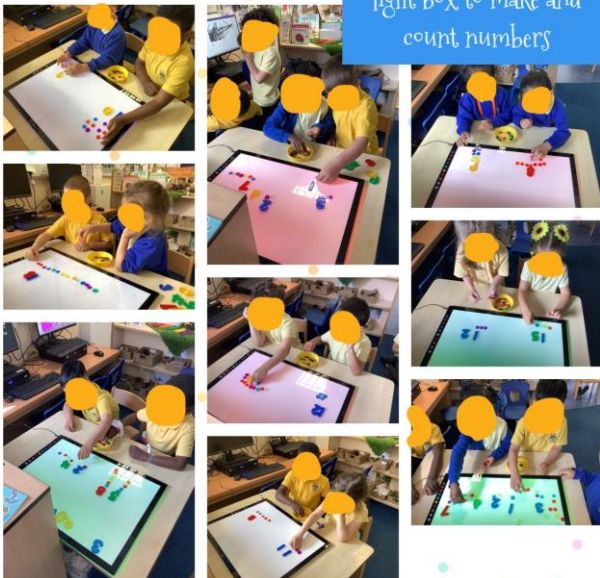
### What impact has the resource had on the children?
